



Memorandum of Understanding  
Between UNC Pembroke and Sandhills Community College

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and understanding between UNC Pembroke (UNCP) and Sandhills Community College (SCC).

credit hours. These students will participate in North Carolina's Reverse Transfer Program so they can obtain an associate degree from SCC with the credits earned from UNCP.

The above goal will be accomplished by undertaking the following activities:

1. Qualified applicants are selected by UNCP for this competitive program. Selection is based on the student's high school academic record. The selected individuals will begin their academic journey at SCC prior to transferring to UNCP. Transfer can take place after 30 credit hours are earned at SCC.
2. These students will be co-admitted to SCC and UNCP.
3. Students will enroll in courses included in the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement (CAA) so as to ensure transferability. Note: Only courses with a grade of "C" or better will transfer.
4. Co-admitted students will receive academic advising and support from both SCC and UNCP through a collaborative advising model.
